<u>Application Deadlines</u> are 5:00 pm on February 15th for admission to the fall semester and 5:00 pm on September 15th for admission to the spring semester. Late applications will only be considered after all other applications submitted on time have been evaluated

Admission decisions are made by the Department of Nursing Student Affairs Committee (SAC). You will be notified via your Southeast Email of the SAC's provisional decision by the end of the sixth week of the semester. The top applicants will be required to enroll in NS271 in the last 8-weeks of the current semester. Admission into NS271 does not guarantee admission into the nursing program, however, failure to enroll or successfully complete NS271 will disqualify the student for consideration of admission. Final decisions will not be made until the current semester's grades have been posted and satisfaction of admission requirements have been verified. All students who were provisionally admitted into the program will receive notification regarding final admission status within one week of final course grade availability. Students will be required to acknowledge any offered seat with their acceptance or rejection.

<u>Under no circumstances</u> will the committee's decision be provided via telephone either to the applicant or to any members of the applicant's family
