Viewing a Student Folder

Currently, academic advisors have full access to student folders and faculty have limited access to a student folder, as information available is role and permission based. Faculty and faculty advisors will have access to students that they have a relationship with. As a faculty advisor, you will have more information on your advisees, but in your faculty role, you will have limited information available on your students in your classes. This is similar to your access to information in the student portal now.

- 1. From your Students list, click the hyperlink associated with a student's name. Anywhere you see a student's name as a link it will take you to his or her folder.
- From the student's folder, depending on your level of access, you will find information on...
 - Appointments (past/upcoming)
 - Grades (past/current)
 - Notes (you added/shared with you)
 - Tracking history
 - Courses and Networks

 - Add a note.
 - Email a student.
