

Priority Registration: Students who have registered for classes *prior to July 17, 2018* for the Fall 2018 semester must have all fees and charges (including housing and meals) paid by July 27, 2018. Failure to pay your account balance by July 27, 2018 may result in late fees and CANCELLATION of your class schedule.

Late Registration: If you enroll or add Fall 2018 classes *on or after July 17, 2018*, you must have all related fees and charges resulting from this activity (including housing and meals) paid by August 24, 2018. Failure to pay your account balance by August 24, 2018 may result in late fees and CANCELLATION of your class schedule.

NOTE: You may not receive a billing statement for this registration activity. Please review your online Account Summary for charge & payment detail.

FINANCIAL AID

SOUTHEAST EMAIL & ONLINE SERVICES

The University routinely sends important notifications to students at their Southeast e-mail address. Students are responsible for all information sent to their Southeast account. **Check your Southeast email regularly** to ensure that you are not missing important billing or financial aid information which could cause late fees, cancellation of your class schedule, or delays in financial aid processing.

- **Account Authorization**–grant an authorized user full access to your account summary (excluding direct deposit)
