<b>3</b>	To Postpone (to a certain time)	To drop a matter and specify a time to take it up	no	yes	time only	yes	majority

<b>5</b>	To Take from the Table	To return to a matter previously tabled	no	yes	no	no	majority
<b>6</b>	To Move the Previous Question	To end debate and vote on the motion	no	yes	no	no	2/3
<b>7</b>	To Refer to Committee	To have further study, or to delay	no	yes	yes	yes	majority
<b>8</b>	Point of Privilege	To object to noise, presence of non-member, etc.	yes	no	no	no	Chair
