

**14. Communication:** Portable Clearcom, hard-wired. Jacks SL, SR, pit, orchestra, control booth, balcony, mix position, catwalks, follow spot booth, box office, and more. Monitors in all dressing rooms and backstage hallways.

## VII. Properties

- 1. Music stands and lights: Available with advanced notice. Available quantities will vary.
- 2. Piano: 2-ea nine-foot Steinway D. Others available. Tuning requires 2 weeks' notice.
- 3. Tables: All are black, 2'-6" deep: 12-ea 8'-0" wide, 6-ea 6'-0" wide
- 4. Chairs: Black orchestra chairs and a variety of others are available. NOTE: We cannot guarantee local availability of special orchestra chairs (e.g. bass stools, cello chairs, etc.). If your musicians have special needs, such equipment should be carried by the company.
- **5. Band platforms and choral risers:** A variety is available with advance notice.
- **6. Smoke/fog/haze/open flame/pyro:** No permits required. However, specific, detailed information must be provided on the use of fire, open flame, flammable devices, smoking or electronic smoking devices, fog, haze, strobe, lasers, weapons, pyrotechnics, amplification over 110 dB at 10 feet, or any other hazards. Lasers or laser projectors must comply with the Food and Drug Administration's Laser Performance Standard. Proper documentation must be provided as to the safety and classification of lasers to be used.

# VIII. Wardrobe / Dressing Rooms / Production Office

NOTE: Backstage hallways are shared with University faculty, staff and students in pursuit of the University's academic mission.

- 1. THIS IS A <u>SMOKE FREE CAMPUS</u>. As an accommodation to touring companies, smoking is permitted on the loading dock as far away from the man-door as possible or <u>inside</u> touring company vehicles while on <u>University property</u>. Smoking as part of a performance is OK.
- 2. Production office, located off stage right, can comfortably accommodate up to 3 people. 2 telephone lines provided; contact production manager (see page 1) for unpublished phone numbers. Internet: 2 hard-wired jacks provided; for Wi-Fi, use open network: RC Touring.
- **3. Dressing rooms:** All are handicapped accessible, separate from audience restrooms, with rolling costume racks, make-up mirrors, lights, chairs, sinks, and hot & cold running water.
  - a. Principal dressing rooms: 2-ea, 4-person with restrooms & showers
  - **b. Ensemble dressing rooms:** 3 interconnected (connecting doors may be locked) with restrooms and showers, 18 persons per room with men & women restrooms & showers
  - c. Temporary dressing room: 12-person with gender neutral restroom but no shower
- **4.** Wardrobe workroom: Nearby reception hall may be used if not needed for company meal.
- **5. Laundry room** with 1-ea full-size washer & dryer is located between dressing rooms and stage. Also, we have free use of multiple washers and dryers, located in a nearby residence hall within rolling distance for hampers & racks, but <u>not</u> via a covered walkway.
- **6.** Wardrobe racks: Multiple, rolling "Z-racks" are available in all dressing rooms.
- 7. Dry cleaning: None on-site. Nearest is at laundromats on Broadway St., approx. 1 mile.

## IX. Sound NOTE: All equipment is well maintained, but nevertheless subject to availability.

- 1. System settings and controls: The hall's sound system is designed to give the user capability of Left/Center/Right (LCR) control while also providing smooth and even sound distribution to every seat in the hall. The system has a proprietary push button control for system power up. This control also allows for muting of unused portion of the system. The push button control allows simplified commands to be sent to a Crestron Pro 2 processor which then recalls the desired settings from the BIAMP AudiaFLEX processor which processes all house equalization, balancing and digital delays.


**Cabling:** The facility has a more-than-adequate amount of microphone, monitor and subsnake cabling in a variety of lengths.

- **8. ALDS:** Sennheiser SI1015 infrared assisted listening system runs independent from the playback system.
- 9. Backstage and lobby monitor and paging systems: All backstage areas and lobbies are on separate monitoring systems using a permanent overhead monitoring microphone. Both systems can be used for paging independently from control booth stage manager's position.

### 10. Location of Consoles:

Due to the limited seating capacity of the Bedell Performance Hall:

- a. Sound: The only available sound mix position is in the first balcony level in an area 9'-3" wide by 6'-2" deep (internal dimensions) with an extra 3' by 3' rack area on right side.
- **b. Lighting:** The lighting console is almost always placed in the control booth behind the Mezzanine level or with the sound console in the area indicated above.



- 11. Projection may be from within lighting control booth or anywhere we can make it work.
- **12. Room acoustics** may be modified to user's preference through adjustment of ten acoustic draperies located against audience left and right walls (five each side).




**From the north or south:** Take **Interstate 55** to **Exit 95** in **Cape Girardeau, MO**. From either direction, turn right onto **Missouri Route 74**. Continue east about three miles. Just <u>before</u> crossing the Bill Emerson Memorial Bridge into Illinois, turn left onto **Fountain Street** and take an immediate right onto the **River Campus**.

**From the east (Illinois):** From **Interstate 57**, take **Exit 30**; from **Interstate 24**, take **Exit 16**. Follow **IL-146-west through Anna**. At the roundabout, take your <u>second</u> exit, essentially going straight, following **IL-146-west** all the way to **Missouri**. Cross the **Bill Emerson Memorial Bridge** and turn right onto **Fountain Street**. Take an immediate right onto the **River Campus**.




Regional Map (travel distances & times are approximate; local maps are on following pages):


