CURRICULUM CHECKLIST

To obtain a bachelor's degree, you must complete:

- 120 semester hours of degree credit (minimum)
- General Education requirements
- · A Major, which is your specialized area of interest
- A Minor to complement major, if required
- Minimum grade point averages
 - Overall 2.0 for most programs
 - In major area 2.0 for most programs
 - Courses taken at Southeast 2.0 for most programs
- Elective Credits depending on program of study

A full-time student will take 12 hours per semester. To graduate in 4 years, students must take a minimum of 15 hours per semester.

General Education Requirements – some requirements

may be fulfilled by coursework in major program

- Social and Behavioral Sciences 6 hours
- Constitution Requirement 3 hours
- Written Communication 6 hours
- Oral Communication 3 hours
- Natural Sciences 7 hours (from two disciplines, one to include a lab)

- Humanities & Fine Arts 9 hours (from at least two disciplines)
- Additional requirements 5 hours (to include UI100 for native students)
- Civics examination
