Prerequisite Shadow Form

Applicants to the SEMO/CGCTC Respiratory Therapy Program are required to shadow with Respiratory Therapists in an inpatient clinical setting for at least SIX HOURS at one of the listed sites below or at a clinical site that is pre-approved by the RT Program Clinical Director - Kyle Kern M.S., RRT. Shadowing must be completed prior to interview and within the current academic school year.

Note: Performing shadowing may require certain immunizations and educational requirements based on the respective hospitals policies. All students will have to follow that particular hospitals' policies. Please dress professional (no blue jeans or shorts) and show cleanliness.
