Are you Eligible to Student Teach During the Spring 2025 Semester?

If so, please be aware that if you do not already have a substitute certificate, we highly recommend that you apply for your substitute certificate by **July 26, 2024**. Instructions on how to apply for your Sub Certificate can be found under "Sub Certificate" here.

The deadline to apply for student teaching is **September 6**, **2024**. Instructions for the application process can be found here. (**PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS FOUND ON THIS PAGE.** Important dates on this website will not be updated until after commencement).

Follow this <u>link</u> to complete an application for student teaching. Once you have completed the application, a link to upload your documents will be sent to within 5 business days.

Also, know that you will be required to pass all sections of the MoCA OR Praxis exam prior to student teaching. Some students in the past were not able to student teach, because they waited too late to take the exam.

- You can take the MoCA exam until June 23, 2024. Follow this <u>link</u> to register for the MoCA exams.
- You can start taking the Praxis exam beginning July 1, 2024. Registration for Praxis exams is open <u>here</u>.

Background Checks

If you are planning to do field work in PreK-12 school buildings during the Spring 2024 semester, you are required to have an up-to-date fingerprint background check on file with the Teacher Preparation Program. Field work courses include CE364, CE480, ED280, EL314, EL350, EL430, EL480, EX309, EX480, ME222, ME270, SE355, SE380, SE465, and any other course that requires field work in a school. (If you previously obtained a background check for the Southeast Missouri State University Teacher Preparation Program, it has not expired.) To see if your background check is up to date with the Teacher Preparation Program you can find this information in your Support Net Notes section. To obtain a new background check, you must go to the following website and follow the directions provided.

Praxis Test Registration Reminders

When registering for Praxis exams, please remember the following:

- Include your Social Security Number when creating a profile. This is currently listed as optional on the site but in order for DESE's certification system to connect scores to an individual, they need an SSN tied to them. We are working with ETS to change the language on the site to reflect that this as a requirement for Missouri.
- Test takers receive a free Interactive Practice Test when they purchase their exam. This free practice test does not show in your cart until close to the end of the checkout process. There are pop-ups to add on extra practice tests or study material prior to the free test showing in your cart.
- When taking the test at home, Microsoft Edge is the preferred browser. Customer
 Service advised that using Microsoft Edge resolves some of the technical issues one
 may encounter when registering.

New 90% Online Blended Option Elementary Education B.S. Degree Program – Pass the Word!

Southeast Missouri State University is introducing in the fall of 2024 the new 90% online blended and 10% Zoom option for earning a B.S. degree in Elementary Education. Students currently have online options for their freshman/sophomore classes; however, the new option

for Elementary Education will allow students to complete junior/senior level classes in the Literacy, Content, and Advanced Blocks through 90% online and 10% Zoom. Students will meet through Zoom three (3) times per semester during the 1st, 8th, and 15th weeks in afternoon/evening so that working and non-traditional students will have the option to obtain their Elementary Education degree. Students will still be required to earn their field hours (TBA) and student teaching in person.
