Friday, September 20: Free Cape Girardeau District Substitute Teacher Training

The Cape Girardeau School District will be hosting a FREE Substitute Teacher Training session from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Friday, September 20, 2024, in Scully 316. Substitute teaching is a great opportunity to gain experience and to have school personnel get to know you. It will increase your teaching skills and improve your resume. This training will enable participants to substitute teach in the Cape Girardeau Public School District. The daily sub rate for Cape Schools is \$110 for a full day or \$55 for half day. In addition, the district will pay \$75 for attending this training after you have substituted in a district school for one day. A valid substitute certificate is needed in order to sub. Anyone with a high school diploma who takes a 20-hour on-line class with DESE may apply or anyone who already has 36+ credit hrs. Student Teaching in Chile – Deadline is Oct 30

Student Teaching in Chile is being planned for the Spring Semester of 2024. There have been a number of changes in the program due to the circumstances of the last few years.

- Dates for the experience are set for 4/2/24 5/10/24.
- Students must complete the required 60 days of student teaching in Missouri (or a reciprocal state) in order to meet certification requirements.

- Only four (4) elementary positions will be available. There is no longer an option for secondary or exceptional child majors to participate.
- Students will be housed with host families as Eagles' College no longer owns an apartment building.
- Students must be able to provide proof of health insurance and that the insurance will cover out of country treatment.

Background Checks

If you are planning to do field work in PreK-12 school buildings during the Spring 2024 semester, you are required to have an up-to-date fingerprint background check on file with the Teacher Preparation Program. Field work courses include CE364, CE480, ED280, EL314, EL350, EL430, EL480, EX309, EX480, ME222, ME270, SE355, SE380, SE465, and any other course that requires field work in a school. (If you previously obtained a background check for the Southeast Missouri State University Teacher Preparation Program, it has not expired.)

To see if your background check is up to date with the Teacher Preparation Program you can find this information in your Support Net Notes section. To obtain a new background check, you must go to the following website and follow the directions provided.

Praxis Test Registration Reminders

When registering for Praxis exams, please remember the following:

- Include your Social Security Number when creating a profile. This is currently listed as
 optional on the site but in order for DESE's certification system to connect scores to an
 individual, they need an SSN tied to them. We are working with ETS to change the
 language on the site to reflect that this as a requirement for Missouri.
- Test takers receive a free Interactive Practice Test when they purchase their exam. This free practice test does not show in your cart until close to the end of the checkout process. There are pop-ups to add on extra practice tests or study material prior to the free test showing in your cart.

When taking the test at home, Microsoft Edge is the preferred browser. Customer
Service advised that using Microsoft Edge resolves some of the technical issues one
may encounter when registering.
