

With the announcement today by Illinois Governor Pritzker of a shelter-in-place recommendation for residents of Illinois, we want to confirm for you an option to change your move out day and time if needed. We remain committed to the tiered move-out schedule that was shared on March 18 to reduce the number of people with access to our campus. Many residents from Illinois are actively moving out of the residence halls at this time and have expressed their appreciation in making the halls available for them to collect their belongings. For all of our students and families, we strongly encourage that you practice social distancing or other safety measures while on campus and moving throughout the residence halls.

As an Illinois resident, we understand you will need to consider Governor Pritzker's guidance for yourself and your family. The option to request a different date and time for moving out of the residence halls remains available to you should you decide to shelter-in-place as noted in Governor Pritzker's press conference. Residents may request an alternate move-out day or time by completing the Departure Request form on the housing portal in their student portal (on the Student SS tab). Those requests are reviewed daily and students will be contacted via phone or email to follow up with their request.
