Spring 2020 Student Teaching

If you have registered to student teach in the spring of 2020, your placement will be announced in Chalk & Wire on one of the three following days:

- Friday, November 8
- Tuesday, November 26
- Friday, December 13

Any student teaching placement that has been confirmed by each of those dates will be documented in Chalk & Wire. If you do not see your placement in Chalk & Wire, then the Office of Field Experiences does not have confirmation from a school district. All placements will be announced in this way, and NO placements will be announced, either verbally or in writing, by Field Office personnel. Chalk & Wire Records

Candidates: Your major assessment results are documented in Chalk & Wire. This includes—among other items--disposition evaluations, some field evaluations, key program assessment, and MoCA scores. These results are used to evaluate your progress in your programs and, sometimes, to determine eligibility for a future stage—like student teaching. Be sure to check these records from time to time to track your progress and to ensure that they match with your personal records. In particular, please check your MoCA scores to ensure that they were uploaded to Chalk & Wire correctly.

New for Spring 2020 Registration

Students that are seeking certification in **Middle, Secondary, or K-12 programs** will see a change in how they register for classes this semester. As part of a pilot program, the Department of Leadership, Middle, and Secondary Education is going to paperless registration. That means that students will no longer have to seek out several signatures to turn in for registration. They should be able to register themselves for the courses that they need through the on-line portal. **Students will need to be fully accepted into the Teacher Preparation Program in order to register for Education courses.** Students provisionally accepted, or who must take EX390, will need to email show@semo.edu what sections they want to register for after their priority registration date. **Students going into student teaching in the Spring will not need to register at all.** We have already registered student teachers for their courses. Please submit your application to the DESE website prior to the end of the fall semester. If you are completing a program, it is recommended that you apply for licensure, even if you don't plan to teach right away.
