Position Description

Reading Instructors guide campers through an integrated reading experience that encourages an enthusiasm for reading and learning. Throughout the summer 3rd graders read a book chapter by chapter while applying concepts from the book to activities around camp.

- Interpersonal skills, especially with regards to accepting guidance and feedback
- Organizational, written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to provide a safe environment and proper care for campers
- Superior teaching abilities

- Ability to plan and implement activities for maximum effectiveness
- Ability to effectively assess levels of student achievement, analyze results, and prescribe action for improvement
- Ability to work and navigate in a variety of environments and weather conditions
