## Accreditation Visit

The Teacher Preparation Program will be welcoming a team of visitors from the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP), on September 16 through 18. If you're not familiar with accreditation, it is simply a thorough review by an external organization. The

review is usually based upon a set of standards agreed upon by the members of that organization. In our case the organization is CAEP, and the standards it uses can be found here: <http://caepnet.org/standards/introduction>. CAEP team members have already reviewed several documents from Southeast designed to address these standards, and now they are coming to campus to verify some of that information and to ask additional questions.

Accreditation is important for several reasons. It enables programs to receive feedback from neutral, outside observers, and it forces them to carefully consider current practices. The results of an accreditation review are also a public recognition of the quality of our programs, and the reputation we earn from an accreditation decision affects us all. ## MAPP2 Exam

The MAPP2 exit exam will now be waived for all education students that have passed the MoGEA. In addition, graduation fees are no longer waived based upon your MAPP2 score.

## Background Checks

If you are planning to do field work in PreK-12 school buildings during the fall 2018 semester, you are required to obtain an up-to-date fingerprint background check. Field work courses include CE364, CE480, ED280, EL314, EL350, EL430, EL480, EX309, EX480, ME222, ME270, SE355, SE380, SE465, and any other course that require field work in a school. Background checks obtained for Southeast Missouri State University are valid for up to one year. For the fall 2018 semester your background check must be valid until the end of the semester (December 14, 2018).
