GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

In order to provide an environment conducive to meeting our educational mission, the university will establish operating procedures describing student's rights and responsibilities.

Every student at Southeast is obligated at all times to assume responsibility for his/her actions, to respect constituted authority, to be truthful, and to respect the rights of others, as well as to respect private and public property. In their academic activities, students are expected to maintain high standards of honesty and integrity.

Procedures for student rights and responsibilities are designed to promote an environment conducive to meeting the educational mission of Southeast Missouri State University.

Alleged violations of student rights and responsibilities are adjudicated in accordance with the established procedures of the judicial system.

The Dean of Students is responsible for the development and administration of the operating procedures.
