PAYING FOR GRADUATE STUDIES

Student Financial Services (SFS) operates as a single service center for all your financial needs. When in doubt, contact SFS to discuss your University financial records. For assistance, call (573) 651-2253 or email sfs@semo.edu. Below are the most common resources used by graduate students to assist with the cost of their education.

- Employer-Provided Funds** Ask your employer if funding is available to assist you with the cost of graduate studies. Contact SFS with any questions related to third party payment arrangements.
- Graduate Assistantships** The types of assistantships are teaching and administrative. Graduate assistantships cover a full tuition and fees waiver for up to 24 hours of graduate course work (up to nine hours fall and spring; up to six hours summer) and pay a stipend of \$8,600.00 per academic year. Southeast offers approximately 170 graduate assistantships annually. semo.edu/grad
- Federal Financial Aid** Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year to determine your eligibility for federal student loans. fafsa.gov
- Payment Plans** An Installment Payment Plan (IPP) is available to distribute current semester charges over two, three or four payments during the semester. Enrollment in an IPP option is required for each semester and is accompanied by a non-refundable service charge. semo.edu/sfs/options
- Endowed and Sponsored Scholarships** Newly admitted and continuing graduate students are encouraged to complete the Endowed and Sponsored Scholarship Application online each year by March 1. semo.academicworks.com
