




Chromebook – How to connect to Southeast’s Wireless Network

1. Click the network icon  in the lower-right corner of your screen.
2. Select your network status from the menu that appears.
3. Make sure Wi-Fi usage is enabled, which will allow your Chromebook to detect nearby networks. In


the menu that appears, click . If you see , that means Wi-Fi is already enabled.

4. While on Southeast Missouri State University grounds, you should be able to see multiple Southeast networks. The main 2 are

SoutheastSecure and **SoutheastResnet**.

Connect to **SoutheastResnet** if you have access to it. You will need to enter some information.

- **EAP method:** PEAP
- **Phase 2 authentication:** MSCHAPv2
- **Server CA certificate:** Do not check
- **User certificate:** None installed
- **Identity:** [YOUR SE-KEY ex: jksmith1s]
- **Password:** [YOUR SE-KEY PASSWORD]
- **Anonymous Identity:** Leave blank
- **Check “Save identity and password”** and do not check “Share this network with other users”
- Click **Connect**.

Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPv2

Server CA certificate: Do not check

User certificate: None installed

5. Open Chrome and go to splat.semo.edu/wifiguest
6. Enter your **SE Key** and **Password** and read over the **Overview of Acceptable Usage Policies**, then scroll down and click **I Accept**.
7. You will receive instructions stating that the registration was successful and you need to reboot your machine. Have your machine fully power off and then back on, and you should be connected.

You may want to repeat steps 4 and 5 for **SoutheastSecure** as SoutheastResnet is only in dormitories and University common areas.
