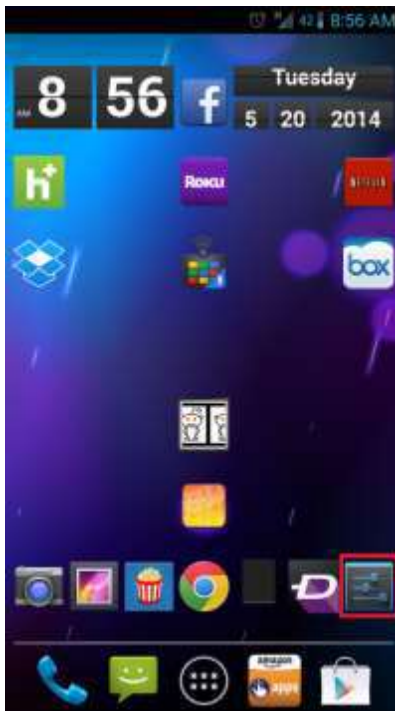


Android – How to connect to Southeast’s Wireless Network with a Guest Account

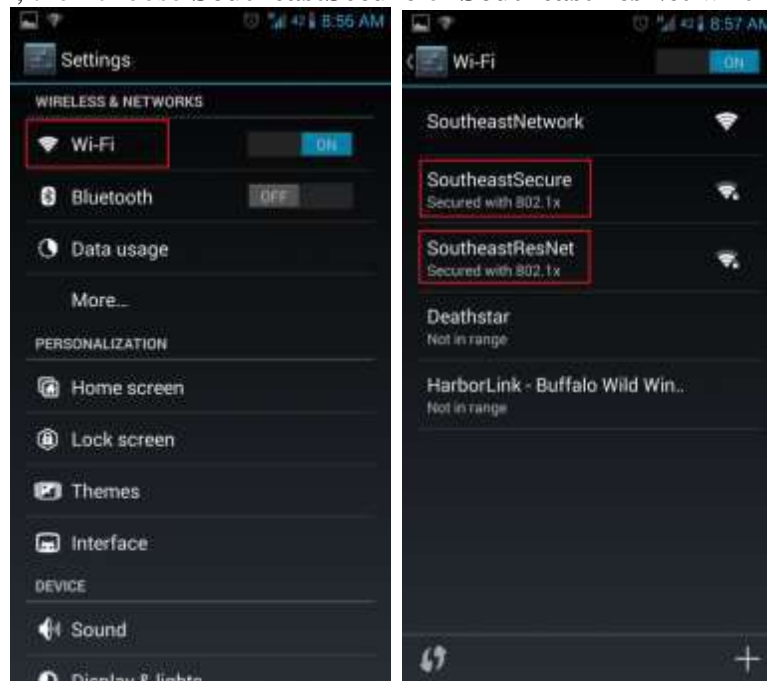
(Android 4.4 and below)

Note: There are Android devices on the market from a variety of manufacturers, and with a number of different versions of the Android software. The screenshots included in this tutorial were made using the versions listed above. The icons and screens displayed on your device may vary slightly from those presented.

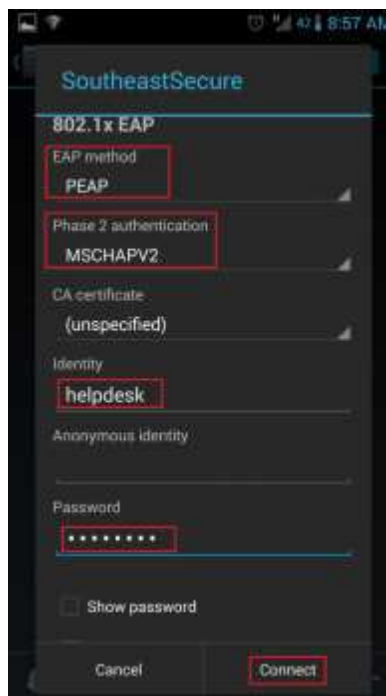
1. Tap the **Settings** Icon



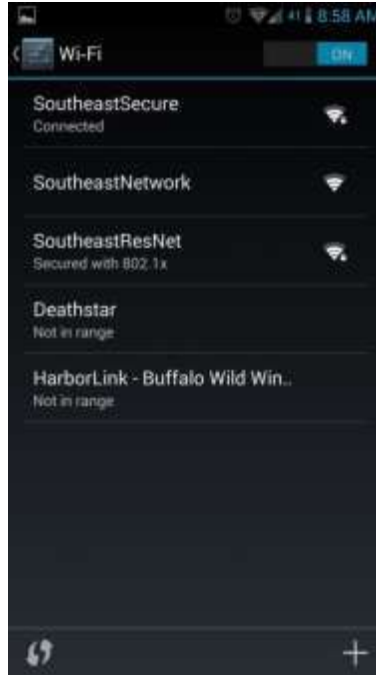
2. Tap **Wi-Fi**, then choose **SoutheastSecure** or **SoutheastResNet** wireless network



3. Change **Phase 2 Authentication** to **MSCHAPV2**. Type in the **provided username** and **password** then click **Connect**.



4. The network chosen should say “**Connected**”



5. After your device is connected it must be registered before it will have Internet access.

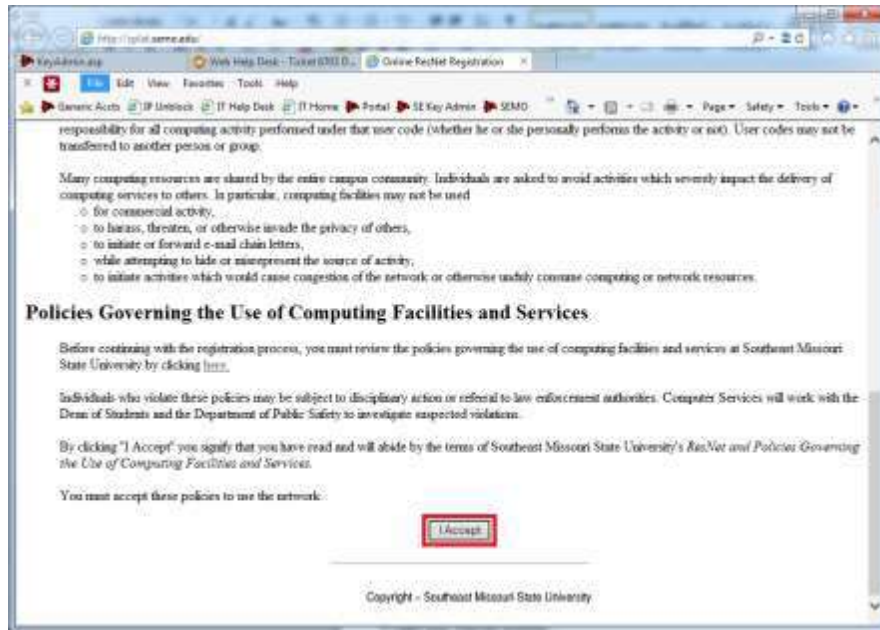
This process must be repeated at the beginning at each semester. To do this:

a. Open Google Chrome

b. The ResNet Registration webpage should be displayed. If your browser does not automatically redirect you to the ResNet page, go to <http://splat.semo.edu/wifiguest>. Enter your SE Key and Password in the spaces indicated.



c. Scroll to the bottom of the screen and tap on the “I Accept” button



d. When the message appears stating that the registration was successful, power your device off & on.

Your device is now setup to automatically connect to the Southeast wireless network. Your device should automatically connect to this network when it detects the signal.
