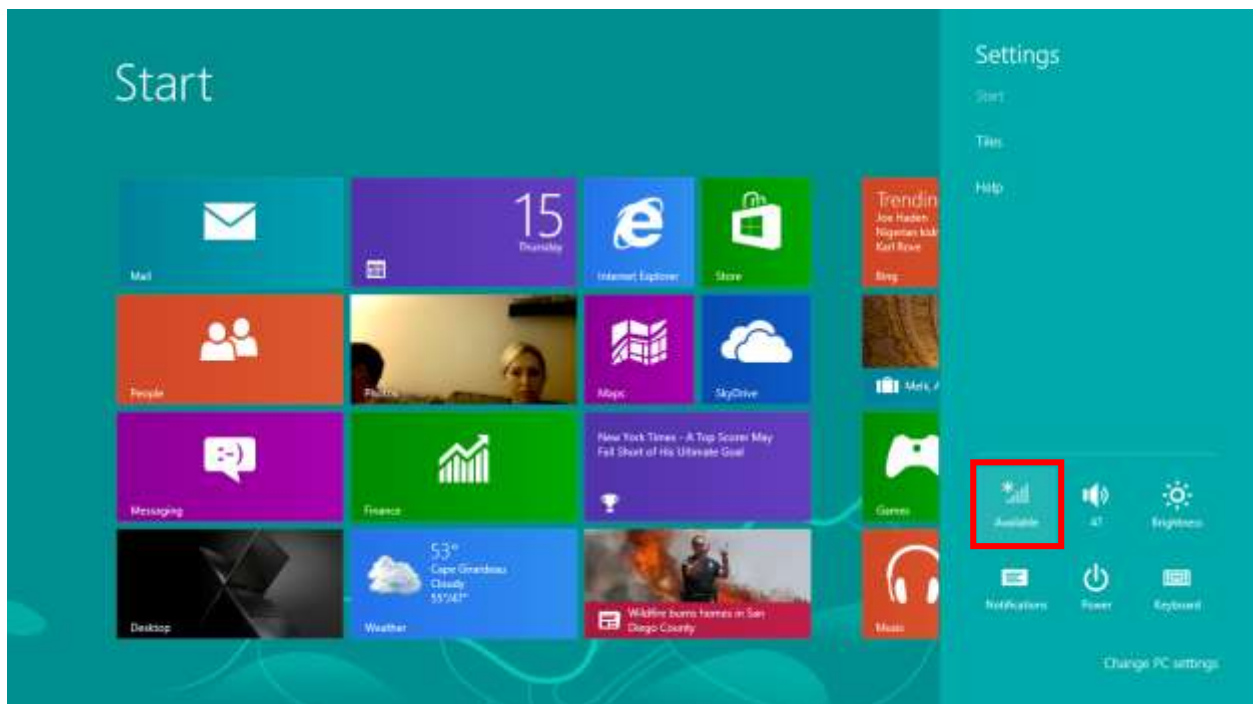


Windows 8 – How to connect to Southeast Secure Wireless Network as a Wifi-Guest

1. Activate the “charms bar” by moving your mouse to the lower right corner or on touch screen by swiping left from the right edge.



2. Click on **Settings** then click the wireless network icon



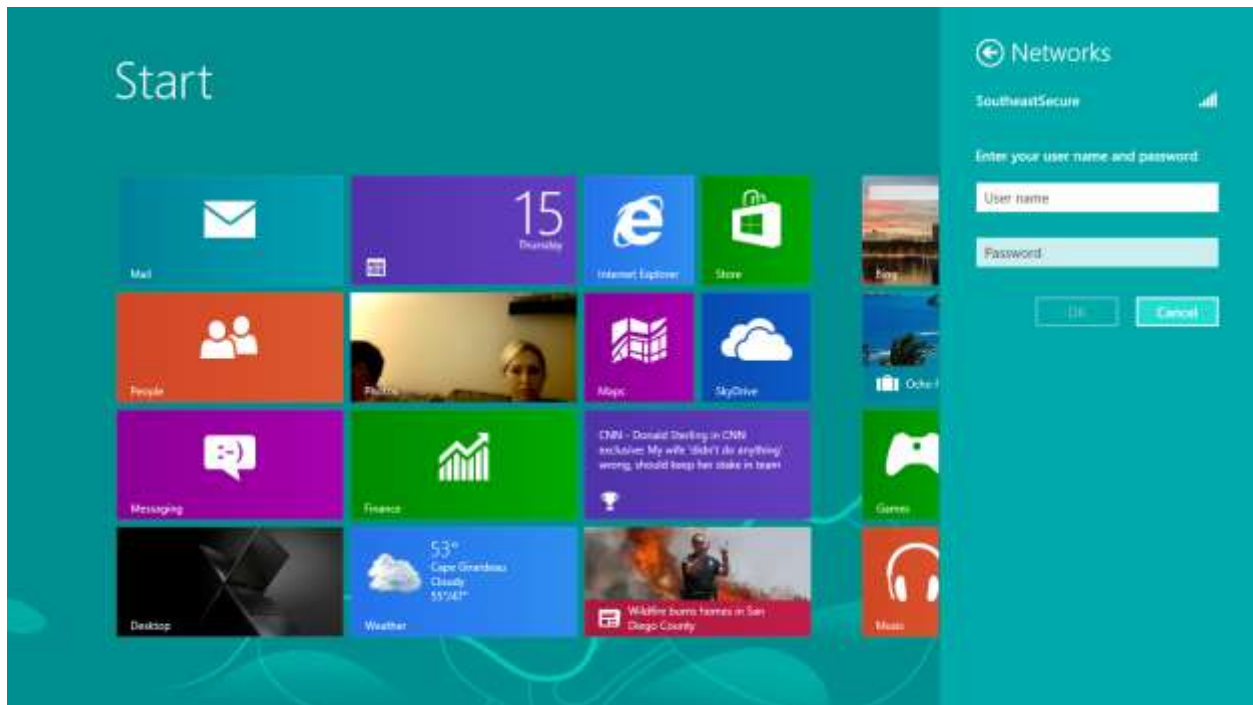
3. Click on **Southeast Secure** (academic buildings)



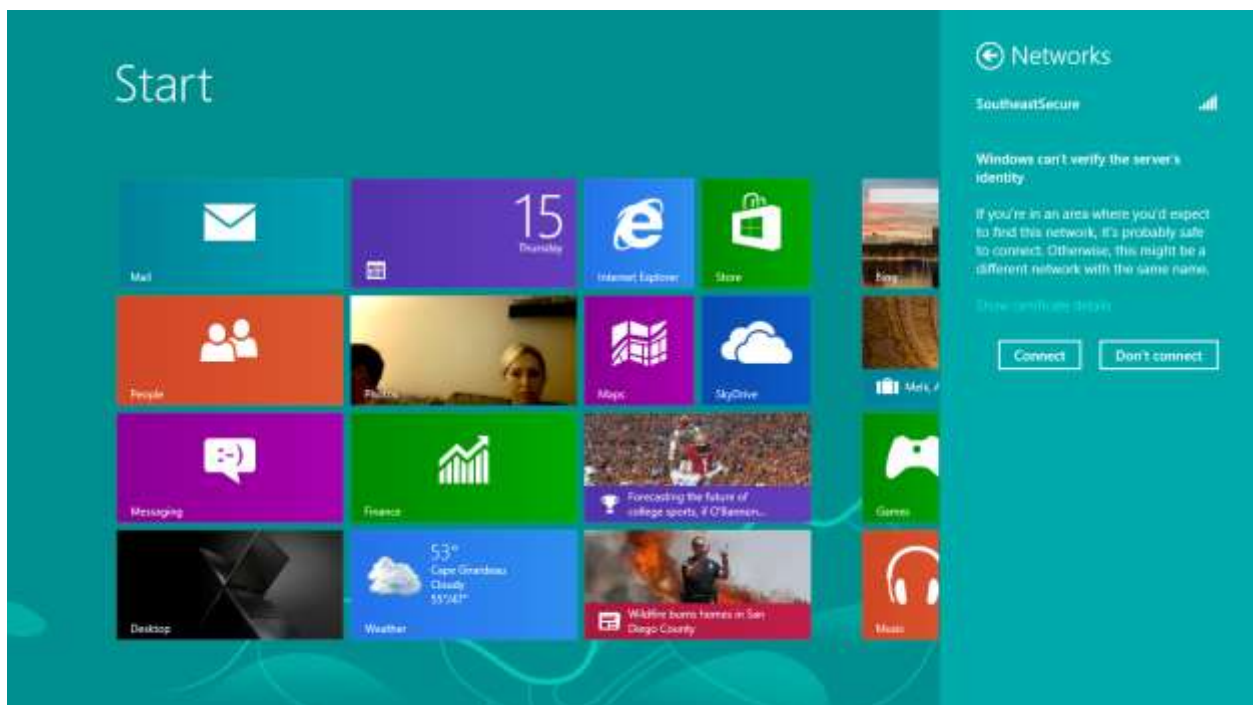
4. Click on **Connect**



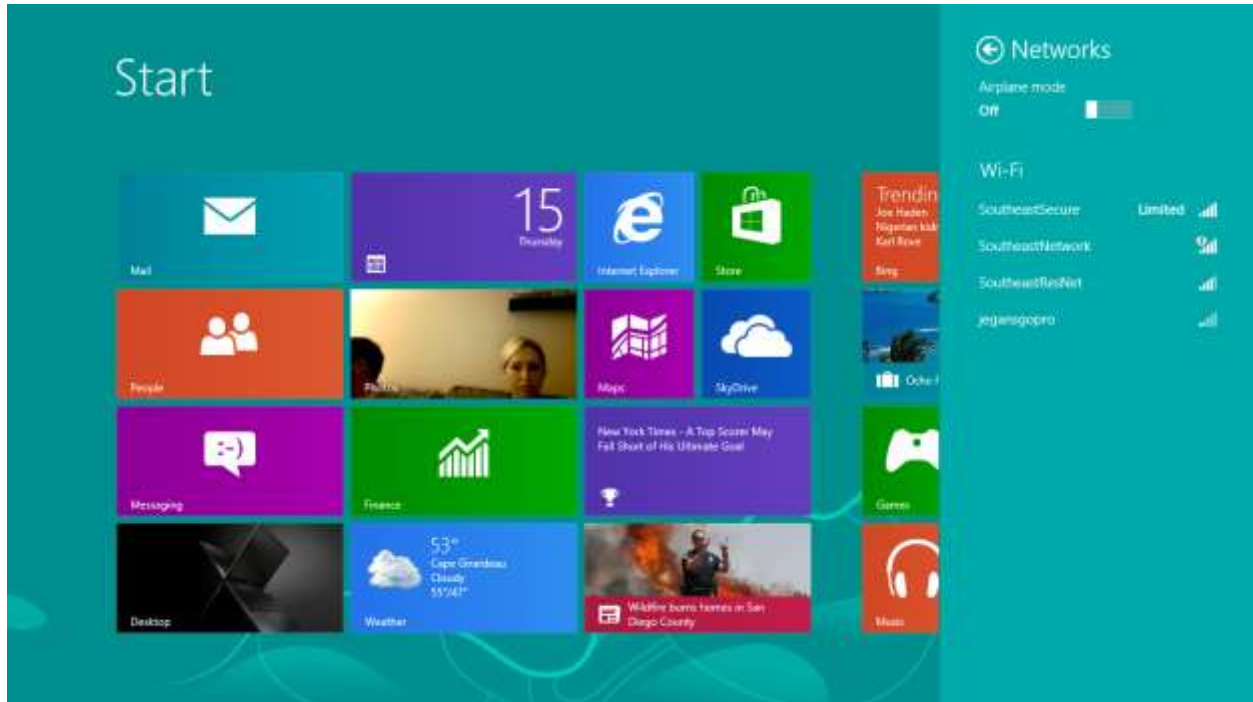
5. In the **User name** text box, type your **Southeast Key**. In the **Password** text box, type your **Southeast Key password**. Click **OK**.



6. Click **Connect** to validate the server certificate

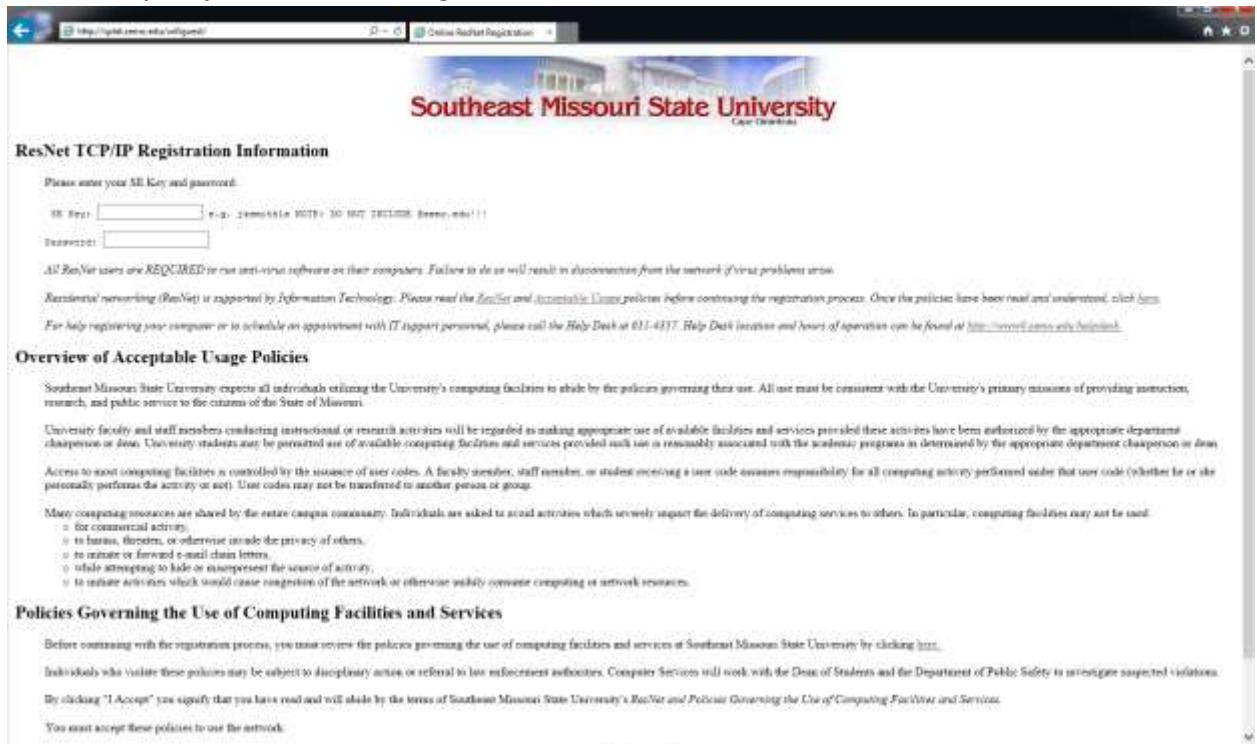


7. Once connected it may display as “Limited” or “No Internet”.

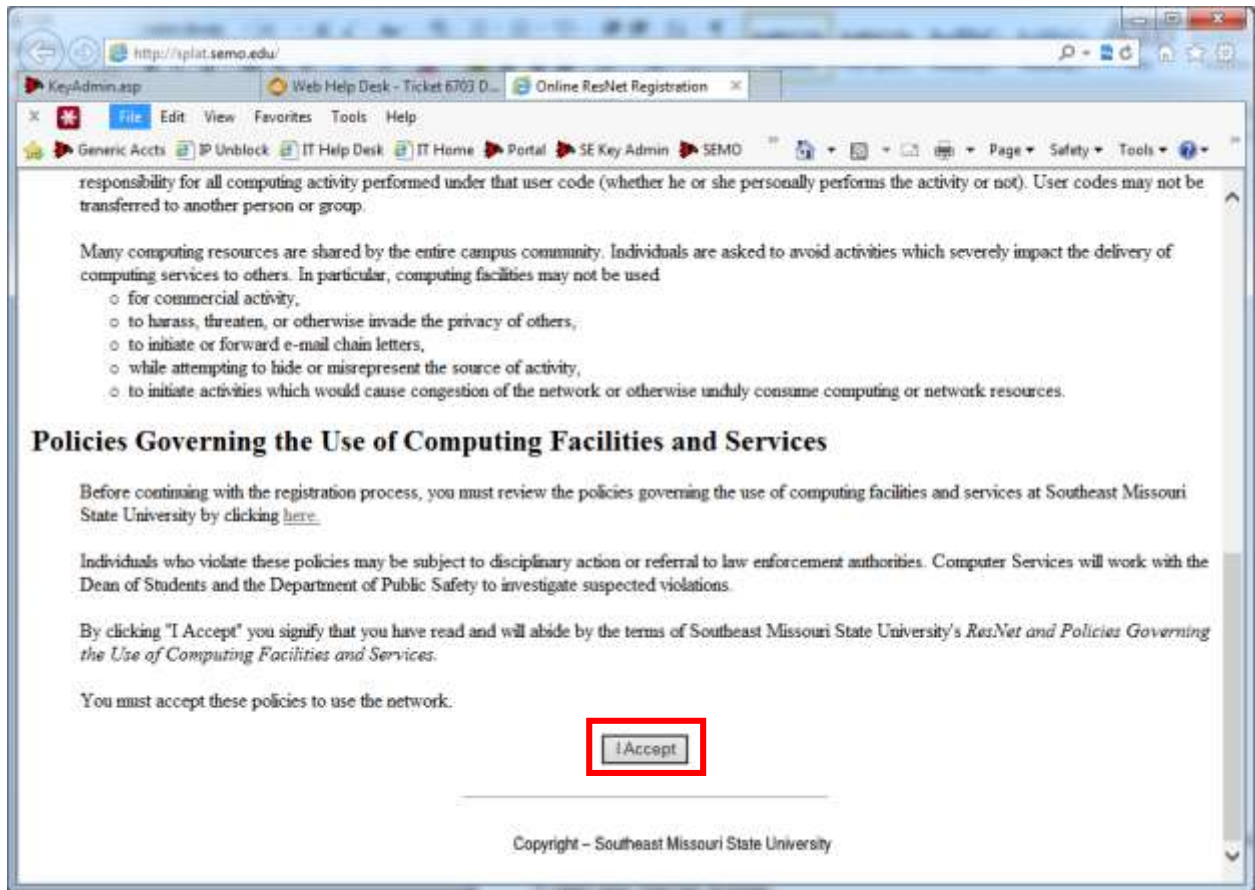


8. In order for your device to work on Southeast’s network it must be registered on the network once per semester. To do this:

- a. Open your Internet browser
- b. Your browser may automatically go to the Resnet Registration page. If it doesn’t enter the address <http://splat.semo.edu/wifiguest>



- c. Enter your **SE Key** and **Password** in the boxes provided, review the policy and click the **I Accept** button at the bottom of the screen.



- d. The next screen should say “Registration successful – reboot your computer”.
- e. Reboot your computer as instructed. From this point forward, your computer should automatically detect the network and connect.
