- Interviews are to be held on November 10th.

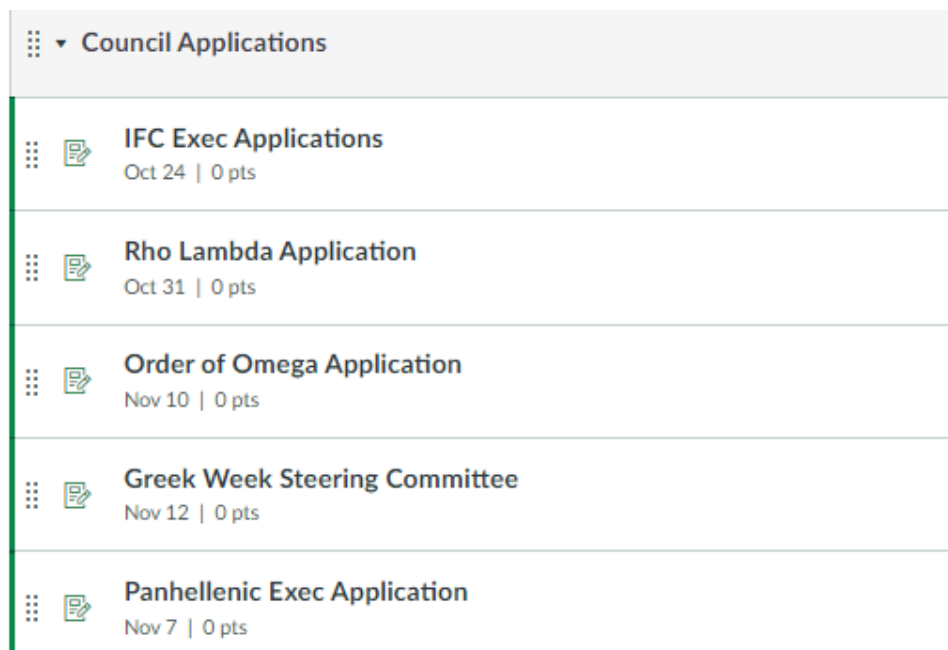
**Rho Lambda** - Applications opened on Tuesday, October 8th, and closed on Thursday, October 31st.
