Dr. Neurohr is the associate professor of trombone at Central Washington University. He is also the principal trombonist of the Cheyenne Symphony Orchestra and the Oregon East Symphony. He previously held positions with regional orchestras in California, Colorado and New Mexico, and continues to perform regularly as a substitute musician with the Seattle Symphony, Spokane Symphony, Colorado Symphony, Hawaii Symphony, Pacific Northwest Ballet, and on movie soundtracks. During the summers, he is the trombone instructor (Session 2) at the Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp and he has been a guest faculty at the Sewanee Summer Music Festival.

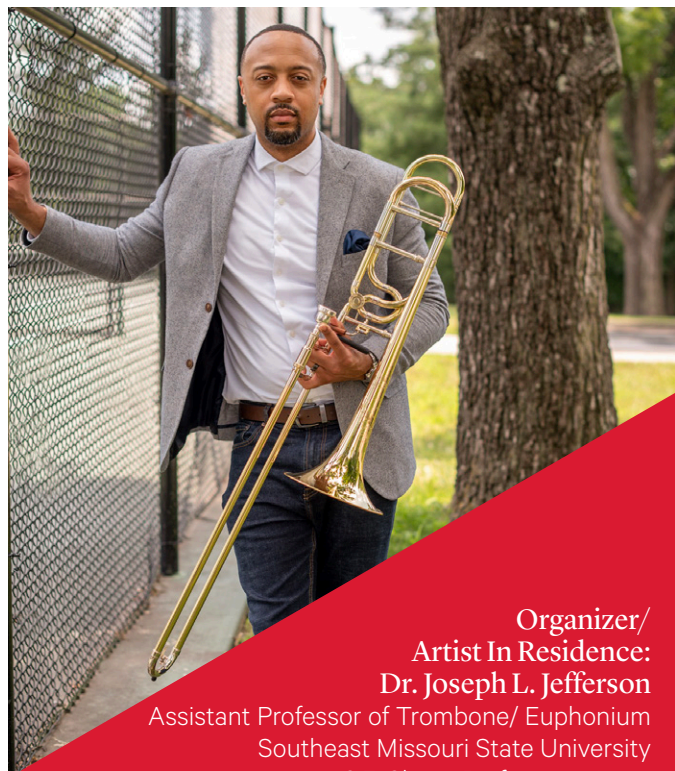
