WEATHER

It's the time of year when inclement weather can strike. In January, Southeast launched [SE Alerts](#). Used only in critical situations, this free service is used to notify our community of delays, closures, events, dangerous situations or threats on all Southeast campuses. SE Alerts will text mobile phones and send an email to University email accounts.

Faculty, staff and students have the option to update their preferred mobile phone contact information, and submit up to four additional personal, spouse, family or parent emails to receive notifications. Students can verify and update their contact information for SE Alerts through the Southeast Portal.

Weather-related campus closure information will also be updated online at semo.edu/closings.

SUMMER AND FALL ENROLLMENT

What is your student doing this summer? Southeast offers an abundance of summer course offerings - most of them online! If your student is interested in taking a summer course, please encourage them to visit with an academic advisor. Summer enrollment begins Monday, February 12.

Fall enrollment begins Monday, April 2. Please encourage your student to make appointments as early as possible so they can register on the first day based on their academic level. Priority enrollment dates can be found on the [Registrar's website](#).

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

It's time to start preparing for the 2018-19 academic year by completing the 2017-18 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) -- yes, it is an annual thing! Southeast's priority processing date was February 1, but if you haven't filed, you can still do so.

March 1 is the deadline to apply for 2018-2019 Endowed and Sponsored scholarships. Encourage your student to submit their application by the deadline at semo.academicworks.com. Students must complete this process every year.

Student Financial Services (SFS) also encourages you to check in with your students regarding their Satisfactory Academic Progress and Scholarship Renewal Eligibility. For information on these policies, contact SFS at (573) 651-2253 or visit semo.edu/sfs

Do you have a Redhawk preparing to graduate?

Are they contemplating graduate school? Being a Southeast alumni has its perks!

All Southeast, non-resident alumni who have earned a bachelor's degree from Southeast Missouri State University and are admitted to [graduate school](#) will be charged the same rate as if they were a Missouri resident.

The approximate value of this award for non-resident, graduate students taking 18 credit hours annually in a face-to-face program is \$4,212. A separate application is not necessary - alumni will automatically receive this rate upon admission to the school.
