**GR 698: Master's Final Written Comprehensive Examination (0 credit)**  
The written comprehensive is an examination over the degree program. Students must enroll in GR 698 during the final semester. If not enrolled in regular coursework a minimum enrollment fee must be paid.

**GR 699: Master's Oral Examination (0 credit)**  
The oral examination will be conducted for students writing a thesis or internship paper in lieu of the written comprehensive examination. Students must enroll in GR 699 during the final semester. If not enrolled in regular coursework or thesis, a minimum enrollment fee must be paid.
