¹ Students who do not have an ACT Math Sub-Score or SAT Math Score on file will automatically be placed into MA050. Students have the option of taking an online mathematics placement exam. There are four (4) different exam levels, and the student can opt to take one or more exams to demonstrate their readiness for a specific mathematics course. Taking the mathematics placement exam is NOT required, but it is necessary if the student wants a higher mathematics placement for their initial mathematics course at Southeast Missouri State University. **Students who have taken or are enrolled in a math course at any institution may not take the Math Placement Exam.
