The Master of Science: Management degree is especially well suited for people who do not have a major at the undergraduate level in business administration but are employed in positions with managerial responsibilities. The additional management training will allow managers to better perform in their current position and advance to mid-level managerial positions. The program provides the business knowledge necessary to work within a business organization or corporation and enhances career options for those in other industries, such as health, advertising, non-profit or engineering.



The Master of Science in Management is designed for non-industry specific education, providing the student with a broad managerial perspective. Electives allow the Management student to focus on specific areas of management. In a climate of rapid changes, graduates of this program will be prepared for the challenges that managers will face.

1. Undergraduate grade point average of 2.75 or above on a 4.0 scale (overall or in last 60 hours)
2. MG301 Principles of Management and PY271 Introduction to Behavioral Statistics or PY571 Introductory Behavioral Statistics
3. At least 3 years of appropriate full-time work experience
4. Current resume/vita including names and contact information of 3 professional/business references
5. Letter of intent addressing preparation for graduate study, ability to succeed at the graduate level and professional goals and objectives.
6. Official GRE, GMAT, LSAT or MCAT score
