iPad Requirements

Whether you are a new student, transfer student, or current education major you will be required to have an iPad Air or newer, (the iPad Air has been discontinued and is no longer available for sale, but we still allow this device for those who may already own one) with 32GB or more. You may purchase an iPad directly from Apple or any store of your choice, from the Southeast Missouri State University bookstore, or bring one you may already own as long as it meets the minimum requirements (**iPad Air or newer, 32GB**). Purchasing from the University Bookstore will provide you the opportunity to use financial aid towards your purchase as well as arrange a payment plan if you wish. If you do decide to purchase from the bookstore, please allow 2-3 business days for shipping. Please contact the University Bookstore at 573-651-2220 or southeast@bkstr.com for any questions. Background Checks

If you are planning to do field work in PreK-12 school buildings during the fall 2018 semester, you are required to obtain an up-to-date fingerprint background check. Field work courses include CE364, CE480, ED280, EL314, EL350, EL430, EL480, EX309, EX480, ME222, ME270, SE355, SE380, SE465, and any other course that require field work in a school. Background checks obtained for Southeast Missouri State University are valid for up to one year. For the fall 2018 semester your background check must be valid until the end of the semester (December 14, 2018).

Are you Eligible to Student Teach During the Spring 2019 Semester?

The deadline to apply is **August 27th, 2018**. To apply go to:

If you have not already applied for your substitute teaching certificate, you should do so immediately. It takes time for the state to process these, and no placement request will be made on your behalf if you do not have a valid substitute teaching certificate. Follow this link to apply for your substitute certificate: <https://dese.mo.gov/educator-quality/certification/checklist-substitute-teachers> .

Also, know that you will be required to pass all sections of the Missouri Content Assessment (MoCA) exam prior to student teaching. Some students in the past were not able to student teach, because they waited too late to take the exam. Start taking the MoCA now so you meet the **December 3rd, 2018** deadline!!!
