- Order of Omega applications for Fall 2017 went out today (10/27) and are due November 9th by 3PM in the Greek Life Office
 - Order of Omega is a Greek honors society for the top 3% of the Greek Community. Currently you need at least a 3.23 GPA to get accepted
- Order of Omega is putting together a Greek Heart Scholarship. We are asking that every chapter donates \$100 or whatever they can to this scholarship.
 - This scholarship is going to go to someone that is passionate about the Greek Community and to the campus as a whole.
 - This scholarship is open for anyone to apply but we do ask that any member that applies their chapter donates to the scholarship.
 - This scholarship will be chosen by an unbiased faculty or staff member either on our campus or on another campus.

New member survey will be going out: Please have your new member educators send us all new member emails, preferably as a group. The survey DOES NOT ask what chapter a new member belongs to or any personal identifiable information. It does ask questions about how they heard about Greek Life, who influenced their decision, and their access to resources on campus. The Office will share information with all chapters once the survey results are compiled.

 - Need every chapter except Sigma Chi, Alpha Delta Pi, and Alpha Chi Omega

- Sigma Nu- Probation through May 2018, (limits on social events through March 2018, service project, and educational follow up).
- Sigma Phi Epsilon- Interim Suspension, pending hearing (can hold meetings, participate in University related activities, including intramurals, philanthropies, and community service projects. Social and recruitment events remain limited at this time)
- Theta Xi- Interim Suspension, pending hearing (can hold chapter in UC)
