### Staffing Update

### Grade Checks

- Registration for fraternity and sorority grade checks are done once a student registers on [semogreeks.com](http://semogreeks.com). If you need a PNM/rushee to have her/his grades check they should register at [semogreeks.com](http://semogreeks.com). By registering this gives the University permission to share their grade information with you. We have also improved the online form where students who are just interested in Greek Life can tell our office about their interest and we will forward their names to the chapters the student expresses an interest in.

### Greek Expansion

- IFC, Alpha Kappa Lambda has expressed an interest in coming to Southeast. AKL has five chapters in Missouri and three in Illinois. As a public university we are always open to a new student organization (Greek or not Greek) that wants to establish themselves at Southeast. Their expansion packet has been

shared with IFC to act upon per their process. The University has not sought out AKL to expand to the campus, they instead identified the campus as one they are interested in exploring colonizing.

- Multi-cultural, Alpha Psi Lambda reached out to the campus this summer and is considering a possible expansion to Southeast. Alpha Psi Lambda is the nation's largest Co-ed Latino Fraternity that was established on 1985 at The Ohio State University and has grown to 31 chapters and 4 colonies in 14 states with 2,800 members.
- A current student is looking to bring AKA back to Southeast. The student is trying to meet with a AKA national officer in the St. Louis area. No information from AKA has been received by the campus and therefore no commitment to return has occurred.

### **Office Cleaning**

- The Greek Life office is purging older files. Some of these include copies of information about chapters from years ago. We will give back to chapters old copies of bylaws, new member programs, newsletters, or other chapter specific information for you to dispose of as you see fit.

### **Greek Timeline**

- The Greek Life office is working to build a Greek Life timeline. This would include the founding/departure of chapters, major events in the Greek system (for example, the building of the Greek Area) and listing major office holders, such as the SG President, Governing Council Presidents, Student Regents and their affiliation. As this idea moves forward we will ask for chapters to share information with the office on alums they know who were in these roles in the past.
