COURSE TITLE: Internship

CREDIT HOURS: 4

I. Catalog Description:

Practical involvement in a performing arts company/venue. Course will be graded on a pass/fail basis. (4)

II. Prerequisites:

- A. Student must have completed a minimum of 75 hours or have senior standing to qualify in a performing arts degree program.
- B. Completion of the performing arts core curriculum requirements.
- C. An overall G.P.A. of at least 3.0 in the performing arts degree program.
- D. Consent of a performing arts faculty member (theatre, music, dance) charged with the responsibility for supervision of the internship and the approval of the proposal by the performing arts degree program committee.

III. Objective:

To provide the student with an intense and sustained performing arts experience in an actual performance setting.

IV. Expectation of Students:

- A. Complete 160 actual work contact hours during the contract period.
- B. Maintain a daily journal of activities.
- C. Compile a portfolio of completed works/activities.
- D. Complete and submit all necessary paperwork to the performing arts faculty supervisor(s).
