- I. **Catalog Description and Credit Hours of Course:** Consideration in depth of subject matter ordinarily unavailable in the departmental curriculum through reading and discussion of assigned material. (2)
- II. **Prerequisites:** Graduate standing; consent of the instructor and permission of the program director.
- III. **Purposes or Objectives of Course:** To provide individual students with the opportunity to study topics pertinent to their individual educational goals when the need for such a topic is not great enough to support a normal course within the program.
- IV. **Expectations of Students:** To carry out assigned readings and other assignments satisfactorily, and to meet on a regular basis with the instructor to discuss course subject matter.
- V. **Course Content:** To be established by the instructor.
- VI. **Textbook and Other Material:** Dictated by the course topic.
- VII. **Basis for Student Evaluation:** To be determined by the individual instructor. The grading policies will be specified at the beginning of the course.
- VII. **Instructors:** Instructors will be drawn from the Environmental Science program faculty.
