Southeast Missouri State University MOST Scholarship Application Deadline April 1

Southeast will offer 25 scholarships of \$500 annually for qualifying students of families who have saved for college through Missouri's 529 Savings Plan (MOST). Awardees will be selected based on high financial need as demonstrated through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Receipt of other grants and scholarships will be considered in determining eligibility.

AWARD CRITERIA:

- Accepted incoming freshman or transfer student, or a currently enrolled student in good academic standing with the University.
- Have a completed MOST application on file with Student Financial Services by April 1 each year.
- Student's family must have participated in the MOST 529 College Savings Plan on behalf of the student for a minimum of 5 years prior to applying for the scholarship.
- Full-time enrollment (12 or more credit hours per semester). MOST awards are not available for summer enrollment.
- Complete and submit FAFSA by April 1.
- Demonstrate high need. Applicants will be selected according to their financial need.
