### Graduate Council Minutes

April 17, 2001

Dr. Cron asked presenters for the two program revisions, new program, and course revision to identify any additional library resources beyond what they already have allocated that would be needed to support these approvals.

Drs. Stennis-Williams, Duff, and Benton shared with the Council information regarding the College of Education faculty's involvement in developing a cooperative web-based M.A. in Education and asked for the Council's support in this endeavor. It was noted that a formal proposal would be forthcoming at a future.

Dr. Summary noted that as graduate programs expand distance learning ventures, programs must ensure that the infrastructure required to maintain these programs is in place.

Dr. Joe Pujol received the Research Fellow Award by a ballot vote of graduate faculty in attendance.
