

# Rend Lake College Courses Which Meet University Studies Requirements at Southeast Missouri State University

Students who complete an Associate of Arts degree or Associate of Science from Rend Lake have completed the lower-level University Studies (general education) courses at Southeast with the following exceptions:

1. Must complete PS220 Missouri Government for 1 hour at Southeast if POLI2101 is taken at Rend Lake or PS103 (3 hours) if POLI2101 is not transferred.
2. Must complete a course that is listed below as Logical Systems requirement
3. Must have at least 18 credit hours of Communication and Fine Arts courses

For the student planning to transfer to Southeast without completing the AA degree, the following courses taken at Rend Lake meet University Studies requirements at Southeast. Some majors will require specific University Studies courses to meet degree requirements.
