FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

It's time to start preparing for the 2017-18 academic year by completing the 2017-18 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)-Yes, it is an annual thing! Southeast's priority processing date was February 1, but if you haven't filed, you can still do so.

March 1 is the deadline to apply for 2017-2018 Endowed and Sponsored scholarships. Encourage your student to submit their application by the deadline at semo.academicworks.com. Students must complete this process every year.
