ORDERS

WARNING ORDER

Is the preliminary notice of an order or action that is to follow.

Warning orders maximize subordinates planning time, provide essential details of the impending operation, and detail major time line events that accompany mission execution.

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ORDERS

WARNO contents

1. SITUATION
2. MISSION
3. EXECUTION
4. SUSTAINMENT optional
5. COMMAND & SIGNAL optional

(Follows the OPORD format)
