



**Articulation Agreement  
between  
Mineral Area College and Southeast Missouri State University  
Associate of Arts  
to  
Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice**

This document specifies the terms for a transfer agreement between Southeast Missouri State University (hereinafter referred to as “Southeast”) and Mineral Area College (hereinafter referred to as “MAC”) and is intended to benefit students at both institutions. This articulation agreement will lead to the awarding of college credit in the above mentioned Criminal Justice program by Southeast for courses successfully completed by students at MAC.


This articulation agreement is intended to prepare MAC students completing the Associate of Arts degree for Southeast’s Criminal Justice program.


MAC and Southeast view this agreement as consistent with the Missouri Coordinating Board for Higher Education guidelines advocating cooperative and seamless transfer arrangements between two-year and baccalaureate institutions.

To ensure the MAC student is ready to enroll in Southeast’s Criminal Justice program, the student must follow the appropriate attached program of study. MAC and Southeast will inform each other of curriculum changes that impact this agreement.

This agreement will become effective with the 2021-22 academic year.
