**Articulation Agreement  
between  
Three Rivers College and Southeast Missouri State University  
Associate of Arts  
to  
Bachelor of Arts in History**

This document specifies the terms for a transfer agreement between Southeast Missouri State University (hereinafter referred to as “Southeast”) and Three Rivers College (hereinafter referred to as “TRC”) and is intended to benefit students at both institutions. This articulation agreement will lead to the awarding of college credit in the above-mentioned programs by Southeast for courses successfully completed by students at TRC.

This articulation agreement is intended to prepare TRC students completing the Associate of Arts degree for Southeast’s Bachelor of Science in History program.


TRC and Southeast view this agreement as consistent with the Missouri Coordinating Board for Higher Education guidelines advocating cooperative and seamless transfer arrangements between two-year and baccalaureate institutions.


